Aim of the test























- Statutory test (taken by Year 1 children nationally)
- 40 words (20 real and 20 pseudo)
- Can children recognise, segment and blend their phonic sounds from phase 2 – 4?

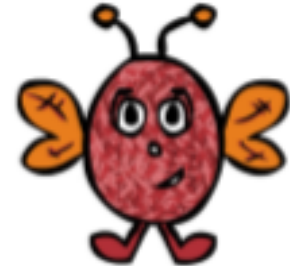

How is the test administered?

- Informal
- 1:1
- With class teacher
- Practise words
- No prompting



What happens if my child doesn't pass the test?

- Pass mark threshold is usually 31/40
- Can re-take in Summer Term of Year 2
- Results published in your child's report at the end of the Summer Term



How can I help to support my child?

- Use the phase 2 – 5 phonics sounds daily; which words use these sounds?
- Read real and pseudo word examples daily
- Download an English phonics app to use at home
- Read daily
- Encourage children to sound out (segment) and blend (put back together) independently
- Ensure correct speech e.g. /ch/ /sh/ /th/ /f/
